



Coach Eric Wolford

As Coach Eric Wolford enters his third season as the Head Football Coach at Youngstown State the momentum the program keeps building should make for not only a very exciting 2012 campaign, but a future as well.

In his second year in 2011, YSU defeated the No. 1 ranked FCS team during the regular season for the first time in school history with a 27-24 triumph at top-ranked North Dakota State. The Penguins set nearly 30 school game and season team and individual records for the year. For the first time since 2006, YSU defeated all three MVFC schools from Illinois and battled Big Ten Legends Division Champion Michigan State to the late stages of the game as well in 2011.

Youngstown State had first-team selections at tailback and quarterback in the MVFC and had finalists for the Walter Payton Award (top FCS offensive player) and the Jerry Rice Award (top FCS freshman) on the season. YSU had all-conference selections on the offensive and defensive lines and more than 20 freshmen saw action during the campaign. In each of his first two seasons, the Penguins have been ranked in the top 25 at some point during the season.

A graduate of Ursuline High School, who played his home games on Stambaugh Stadium's turf, he built an impressive resume serving as a collegiate assistant for 16 years prior to taking over at YSU. Of those, 12 were spent on the FBS level serving as an assistant at South Carolina, Illinois, Arizona, North Texas, Houston, South Florida and Kansas State.
